



Bottoms

- All bottoms (pants, shorts, capris, and jumpers) need to be navy or khaki.
- Shorts should NOT be shorter than fingertip length (with arms down by side). Skirts and jumpers are not to be shorter than 2 inches above the knee.. (In order to get proper length, purchase age appropriate sizes and alter if necessary.)
- Cargo Style (pockets on the sides) pants, shorts, capris, or skirts are NOT to be worn.
- Our plaid color for girls' skirts and jumpers is the green and blue that is available through JCPenney. This color is also available from the French Toast collection, which may be ordered through the catalogue.

Shirts

- Polo shirts must be of uniform style (no fitted, capped sleeves, or short polos).
- All solid color uniform type polos are acceptable (NO logos).
- Button up shirts from the uniform collection is acceptable.
- School (only) sweatshirts may be worn in class.
- Any color turtleneck may be worn (NO logos).
- Sweaters and vests may be navy, white, or red.
- Solid navy, red, or green/blue plaid cross ties for girls are acceptable.

Socks/Tights

- Solid navy, black, white, khaki, or red may be worn.

Belts

- Solid or braided black or brown leather belts must be worn.

Shoes

- All students must wear close-toed shoes. Being a safety issue, this is mandated by the Potomac Conference. **Students are not allowed to wear sandals or flip flops.**

Hair - Skin - Nails

- Hair should be well groomed. Distracting hairstyles or unnatural colors/tints/highlights are not allowed.
- Temporary or permanent tattoos and body graffiti are NOT allowed.
- Clear or light fingernail polish is acceptable.

Other Uniform Guidelines

- Shirts must be worn tucked in.
- Belts must be worn.
- If a student chooses to wear a t-shirt under the polo, it must be **solid white**.
- Ball caps, visors, beanies, and bandanas are not to be worn except for special announced events.
- Jewelry (including rubber bands, wristbands, and friendship bracelets) is not to be worn to school. Students may not wear plastic hole-savers or wear any type of cover over earrings. Please do not allow your child to get his/her ears pierced during the school year, as they will no be able to heal properly.
- Temporary or permanent tattoos and body graffiti are not allowed.
- Coats, jackets, hoodies, and sweatshirts other than DTD uniform sweatshirts must be hung up or put in lockers before school begins.
- School sweatshirts may be ordered in the fall.
